## Walking School Bus Pilot Program >


The WSB Spring Pilot Program is a free service available to Tupper students and parents. This Spring Pilot Program will run from Monday May 26<sup>th</sup> to Friday June 20<sup>th</sup> as a trial- if enough families register!!

Children would be lead to school in groups of 5-8 students by one or two volunteers, departing from their neighbourhood meeting point.

Tupper and the PTP believe that in the face of escalating trends in pedestrian traffic incidents, the Walking School Bus Program provides a safe travel option for the children.

At this time the program would run 2-5 days per week (depending on registration), and in the mornings only. Registration is required by Monday May 5<sup>th</sup>.

# Walking School Bus (WSB) Program Sir Charles Tupper Elementary

A **Walking School Bus** is a group of students led by 1-2 adult volunteers who regularly walk to school together.

#### Why should you consider this program?

It is a great way for students

- ✓ to be physically active,
- to feel happy and more energized for the day,
- to develop good social skills and life-long healthy habits,
- to enhance their academic performance, and
- ✓ to gain independence.

And it is also an excellent opportunity for

#### parents/guardians/caregivers

- ✓ to reduce the daily stress and anxiety associated with the school run by taking turns once a week with others,
- ✓ to get to know other people in the neighbourhood,
- to save on gas, reduce your family's carbon footprint on the planet, reduce the congestion around the school, and
- ✓ to get some additional physical exercise.

The pilot is expected to run for **3-4 weeks this coming Spring**, and will operate daily **Monday to Friday**, in the morning only (or 2-5 days a week depending on the number of families who sign up in a specific area), **from Monday**, **May 26 to June 20, 2025**.

The program is **free** but pre-registration is required.
